In the sole discretion of the Company's board of directors, the Company may, with respect to any applicable vesting date, deliver to the reporting person Common Stock or cash having a fair market value equal to the number of shares of Common Stock underlying the portion of the RSU that vested on such date, payable within 30 days of the vesting date, less applicable taxes.
- 2. The RSUs are scheduled to vest as to 25% of the original number of RSUs on September 11, 2020, and as to an additional 25% upon completion of each successive one-year period thereafter.
